# 1928 GILLSANS

Gill Sans is a san-serif typeface designed by Eric Gill. Gill Sans was first bared in a single up-per-case weight in 1928. The font became popular almost immediately. The proportions of Gill Sans stem from monumental Roman Capitals in the upper case and traditional "old-style" serif letters in the lower. The upper case of Gill Sans is somewhat formed after Roman capitals. Gill Sans success was greatly assisted by Monotype's high-level marketing. Other fonts influenced by Gill Sans are FF Scala Sans and Mr and Mrs Eves.
